

## PLHS BOOSTERS 9/16/09 MINUTES

- A. Welcome and Call to Order: Introductions were done. Attendees: Helena Allen, Tamra Morgison, Lori Coyle, Pam Brown, Dina Bahnmaier, Paulette Ogilvie, Ruth Amerine, LaVell Winsor, Denise Miller, Amy Easum, Claire Bays, Debi Sorrick, Shelee Shafer, Theresa Beatty, JB Elliott.
- B. Secretary Minutes: Passed out and approved.
- C. Administrator's Concerns: Mr. Elliott discussed the Endowment Assoc and encouraged participation through membership/board positions. All the money goes to the students in the form of scholarships, etc. Pamphlets were handed out.
- D. Treasurer's Report: Still a work in progress. Ruth reports that \$3498.72, of the \$13,536.06 in the account, belongs to Boosters pending outstanding concession start up bills and verifying past accounting. Perry Ball Association has paid their account. The balance of the moneys is in holding for the various activity accounts that raise money through Boosters.
- E. Old Business:
  1. Shirt orders – taken at KAW preview and Holton game with over \$3000.00 sold. Orders back by Sept. 21/22. Dina and Paulette were great with the sales pitches. Email forms were profitable also. Discussion was that seeing the shirts actually helped also.
  2. Need volunteers to help package and pass out – Dina, Paulette, Helena – some orders will be delivered to the students at the various schools.
  3. Football programs – many compliments. The original 500 are gone. The next home game is senior night and there will be a senior insert with one time sponsors. We will plan to print 700. Please let Denise know if there are any changes needed before the printing. Dancers will be recognized at a game in winter. Denise will decide if the insert will be two sided or 2 pages. Each senior will be receive the senior insert. Football players get recognized pre game, others at halftime.
  4. Parent Teacher Conferences - Meal tonight went well and ready for tomorrow.
  5. Gate workers – worked out well for last game. Theresa will check if workers are needed for the next game & try to involve all that want to volunteer.
  6. Tailgates-
    - a. JCI – wants to give money to tailgate so will be on 9/25. Need someone to get the grill and cook. Participants bring a side dish or dessert and may do a free will donation. Boosters provides the paper products and have coolers that can be used for drinks. Helena has a flyer that can be emailed out. Starts at 5:30. Will check to see if Dennis or Marty or Mike would cook and if we can at least use Dennis' grill. Tammy and Dina will help with set-up.
    - b. Will check about doing a tail gate for the 10/16 and 10/29 dates.
  7. Senior introductions – Theresa gave list to Helena. Pictures are getting ready to print which won't take too long per Rhonda Gibler.

- a. Peggy and Pam will coordinate flowers and candy to hand out to the parents. Other sport specific senior night activities will need to be coordinated by parents or coaches.
8. Homecoming – Great activities planned this year. Dina may work to come up with a Boosters Float. Activity list was handed out and is on the website.
9. Golf Tournament – Ruth reported that participation is slow. Sponsor lists were out at conferences and she sent out an email to the list she was given. Have only had 6 teams sign up so far. Discounts are available for sign up prior to 9/25. Need volunteers for working the different shifts. Assignments will be made for workers. Suggestions- put flyers up at the golf courses as well as local businesses, email Alumni Assoc, put on First Bank scrolling sign. Denise is getting a flyer available for this. Tournament breakfast starts at 7:00am with play starting at 8:00 am. Mike wants the prizes to him ahead of time. Currently there are 6 hole sponsors, 1 cart sponsor.
10. Fund Raising – Discussion took place about selling KAW decals (local individual) and KAW lanyards. FBLA may want to do the decals – Theresa will have them contact Helena. Paulette was suggested to chair fundraising. It was moved to order 1000 lanyards. Paulette and Dina will man a table, we can put them in the concession stand or walk around selling them. It was decided to sell them for \$3.00 each. We will sell any past decals still in stock.
11. Concessions – cabinets are being donated by Bruce and Pam Burns to put in the Middle School Concessions or Multi Purpose Room so that product can be locked up. Ruth will call the Burns' to set that up.
12. Crock liners were donated by Sally Abel. We will send her a thank you.
13. After Prom has met once and have chosen a theme, have all but one committee head, and need to order inflatable games. Next meeting is 9/23.

Other Business:

1. Discussion about setting limits for activity booster reimbursement to parents doing special or spirit things such as locker decorations, treats, etc. Suggestion was made for Boosters to match up to \$2.00 per student per sport after receipts are turned in. One time per season or activity. Payment will be made after receipts are received.
2. Mr. Elliott is looking into contracting with Coke or Pepsi as they provide scholarships for students. Boosters currently uses 7Up because it was cheaper. The scholarships are based on product sold. Boosters does not have a signed contract.
3. Referee food/drink is taken out of the 10% split of the hosting sport.
4. Discussion took place about lack of support to two sports on the same night because parents don't want to pay or punch twice for the two or more events.
