

**PLHS Boosters – Agenda**  
**Thursday, February 18, 2010**

- A. Welcome and Call to Order** – attendees were Lori Coyle, Shelee Shafer, Tamra Morgison, Peg Hurd, Helen Allen, Ruth Amerine, J.B. Elliott, Paulette Ogilvie, Pam Brown ----- Junior parents joining when the After Prom meeting was over were Deb Sorricks, Denise Miller, Dina Bahnmaier
- B. Secretary Minutes** – distributed with the agenda, reviewed and approved by motion.
- C. Treasurer’s Report** – January statement showed a Booster balance of \$1143.94. As of 2/17/10, after paying expenses, Booster balance is \$-263.78. Fortunately organizations still have money in the general Booster account so we are not overdrawn. Paulette submitted profit of \$58.00 on the raffle and \$106.00 for miscellaneous spirit item sales.
- a. Discussion took place to adjust the distribution of concession profit for 2010-2011 so Boosters has income to cover expenses, let alone needs of organizations. Motion was made to change the split to 50% to the working organization, 10% to the sport, and 40% to Boosters. Motion passed unanimously.
  - b. Ruth is willing to be the treasurer again next year but suggests that there be a co-treasurer to learn the intricacies of the accounting for the following year.

- a. Parent Teacher Conferences – thank you to all
  - b. Winter Sports
    - i. Reimburse for GBB senior pictures - Discussion ensued that Kasi Packard paid for the pictures and not Carrie Volle. The expense for the other sport senior pictures was only \$25.65 for the 19 or so students. There has been a request to parents of GBB to contribute to expenses for various items including coach gifts. If receipts are given to Boosters, the policy is that we can reimburse up to \$2.00 per student once for each activity per season.
    - ii. Wrestling Regional – Friday (2/19) and Saturday (2/20) – Send goodies for the boys. Helen and Lori will **donate** granola and gatorade.
    - iii. Regional Scholars Bowl treat of bottled water and rice krispie treats and granola bars were donated by Pam Brown.
  - c. Fund Raising
    - i. Kaw Basket Raffle – went well. Another raffle will take place 2/26/10.
  - d. Regional, Sub State and State Events
    - i. Wrestling
      - 1. Regional – Feb 19 – 20
        - a. Program – May be too late to submit for the regional and some questions about email that was received just last week.
        - b. Denise Miller still has the art work.
      - 2. State – Feb 26 – 27 – Lori and Helen will make special favors for the state qualifiers.
    - ii. Band/Choir – Kansas Music Education Association Convention - State
      - 1. Feb 25, 26, 27 – no students qualified.

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- iii. Basketball
  - 1. Sub-State – March 1 – 6
  - 2. State – March 10 – 13
  - 3. Program for Basketball Sub State – ½ a page – Helen will check into this.
- iv. KVL Solo's and Small Ensembles – this will probably not take place due to budget concerns across the league. Turner is to host but haven't done anything to organize it as of yet.

- e. Concessions - nothing to report. Going smoothly. This and the pizza trailer purchase is where the majority of Booster expense occurs.
- f. Budgets
  - i. Update from Deb Sorrick regarding the budget meeting will take place at a later date. Helen will contact **Dr. Yoder to make a presentation at our next meeting, Mar 25.**
- g. Other Business
  - i. Sponsor a hole for Jr. Kaw Golf Tournament - \$50 donation – tabled until March pending available funds.
  - ii. Cabinets that were donated – Need to follow-up with Pam Burns as have not been able to get volunteers to get them and weather has been a challenge getting to them. Peggy will contact the Burns to see if the cabinets are still available. Mr. Elliott will check to see if some students could be recruited through Mr. Schrimsher and Mr. Winchester to get them. (*Someone correct spelling on names if they are wrong-I didn't check website*)
  - iii. Painting the pizza trailer – tabled to next year due to budget concerns.
  - iv. Election of officers is upcoming and we need ideas to increase participation so that the same persons are not always the ones doing everything. May also need to review the bylaws. Paulette will re-type the bylaws (current copy is DOS-like format).
  - v. Discussion of fundraising was a car bashing (Shaffer's have a car), elite seating at events based on booster contributions (reserved seating for the musical was very popular), charging admission to the fall scrimmages which could also be membership in Boosters.

**E. Administrator's Concerns – Mr. Elliott** – currently building budgets for 2010-2011 may be cut by 50%. There has been discussion about the high school taking concessions back to generate revenue. Participation fees may increase from once for the year to a fee for each sport. May also choose not to fill or to cut assistant positions, etc., to try to keep the various sport programs available.
