- D. **Business**

 - d. Fund Raising

 - ii. Contribution to the fund for a sound system in lieu of flowers and candy for the vocal group – waiting for information from Mr. Elliott and Mr. Copple on what is functional and what needs replacing.

 - iv. Boosters will raffle a large windbreaker basket and blanket basket with other KAW support items at upcoming games – sell tickets at next available games and draw for the raffle at Senior night 2/16 and 2/26. Paulette will check with administration about the dates and this fundraising effort.

 - ii. Decision was made to limit pizza and drink for Scholars Bowl to just our students and not the other team students. Discussion took place as to why we were providing this for other teams in the first place. Pam said that it was done that way the past 2 years as she recalls and thought the funds were from the Scholars Bowl fund or a fund Theresa had. There are no notes to support the previous years except in 2008-09 minutes that we were providing tickets for only our students so uncertain how this practice came to be but will only provide for our team.
 - iii. Decorating the pizza trailer – it was suggested that we decorate all sides and show support for all sports/activities. Paulette suggested some parameters for a contest and we will discuss that at the next meeting. It was also suggested to offer a prize for the winner and perhaps a matching donation to the club of his/her choice. It was also suggested to check with community boosters to see if they wanted to donate for the material cost and/or prize and be noted in the painting.
