e. Concessions

- i. Funnel Cakes at a December 11 Basketball game.
 - ii. Discussion about winter concessions took place regarding having concessions in the Middle School when there are 3 games going (both freshman teams and one jv team alternating girls and boys). It was also discussed that whoever has the HS concessions should be responsible for the pizza sales and the Middle School concession stand. Pizza will be cooked in the trailer rather than the school kitchen. If the group signed up does not have enough workers, the Middle School wouldn't have to be opened. Drinks, popcorn, and candy will be sold from the M.S. and the group can choose to cook hot dogs in H.S. and keep them in a warmer for the M.S. Smaller clubs can share a night. If the group cannot run the concession stand on the date signed up for, this needs to be communicated to Tamra and the sponsor should not find their own sub group.
