- B. **Secretary Minutes-** passed out and approved after corrections.
- C. **Treasurer’s Report** – Ruth has been able to enter most line items but has not had a chance to go back through and verify the past entries completely. Profit on shirts/jackets was approximately \$400.00. Golf Tournament profit was \$2209.24.
- D. **Business**
 - a. **Shirt Orders**
 - i. Run another order through the winter sports meeting – October 21. Paulette will coordinate this. Persons are asking if the jackets will be available again. They will be. We will only do preorders now that people have seen the products. Can preorder on the website or at the tables and concessions at games. Please notify Ruth in advance of any T-shirt sales through Boosters. She had to clarify communication regarding the soccer t-shirts.
 - b. **Tailgates**
 - i. October 16 – No tailgate for this date. Next home game is 10/29 but there is a chili feed that night so we will not do tailgate that date either.
 - c. **Golf Tournament – October 3**
 - i. Update: Theresa Beatty donated \$35.00 from her job (relief so that the owner could golf). Profit \$2209.24 with fewer teams than usual. Still calculating dividing up the funds toward those who helped and sponsored.
 - d. **Fund Raising**
 - i. Lanyards are here and being sold. There are 25 to a bag. Paulette is coordinating this. We will also have those for sale at the sports meeting. There are still KAW blankets available. There are still decals available. Any leftover items will be for sale at the last two home football games.
 - ii. Singers is selling funnel cakes at the 10/16 game for \$5.00 each.
 - e. **Regional and State Sport Events** – Boosters provides a drink and snack for each post season event. We missed giving a drink and snack for regionals for tennis and golf. Helena will email Theresa to find out if either team has members going to state or are doing a post season party. There are 17 students in tennis and not many in golf. We will make a basket with soda and candy for these teams to make up for missing their regionals.

 - v. Soccer – Regional: October 31, Quarter Finals: November 3, State: November 7- Soccer will host at least one and perhaps two regional games. Shelee and Lori will coordinate this.
 - vi. Football – Regional: November 7, Sectionals: November 13, State: November 28 – Paulette will coordinate this.
- f. Concessions – Middle School PTO is taking over their own stocking and Ruth will just be billing them for stock used. They will do their own start up cash and preparation for serving. Sign up for hs concessions is going well. Some groups could benefit from increased numbers of students working. Tami has emailed the set up and clean up to the groups. There is a \$50.00 fee taken out of profit if the trash is not cleaned up (if an administrator reports it was not done). The cabinets from Burns are not what Ruth envisioned. She will have her husband pick up the cabinets this weekend and will decide what we can use or not use. Boosters is moving their equipment out of the Perry Ball Association building and PBA will not be able to utilize this equipment any longer due to the condition it was left in. (Refrigerator) Boosters will pull the pizza trailer over to use for baseball concessions.
- g. After Prom – Doing a raffle for cash. 1000 tickets were printed and the parents are to sell one book of 10 at \$10.00 per ticket. Parents could mail the tickets back if they could not sell it. Each book sold gives the parent a free ticket. The drawing is 10/29 and the winner could receive up to \$2000.00 cash. There is currently \$2600.00 and they are trying to raise \$7000.00.
