 - ✓ PLMS has been notified by KSDE that we have a sub-group (group of 30 or more like kids) that did not make adequate yearly progress. It was shared that our staff is working hard to help this small group of students improve. It was also noted that PLMS students, as a whole, have earned the Standard of Excellence in both Math and Reading for three consecutive years prior to spring, 2011.
