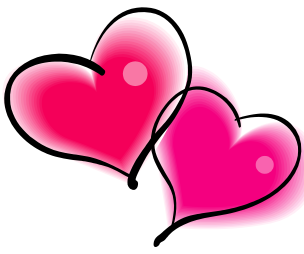

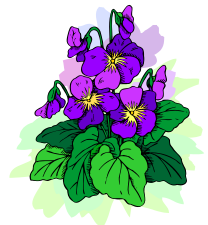

SNOW CREEK TRIP



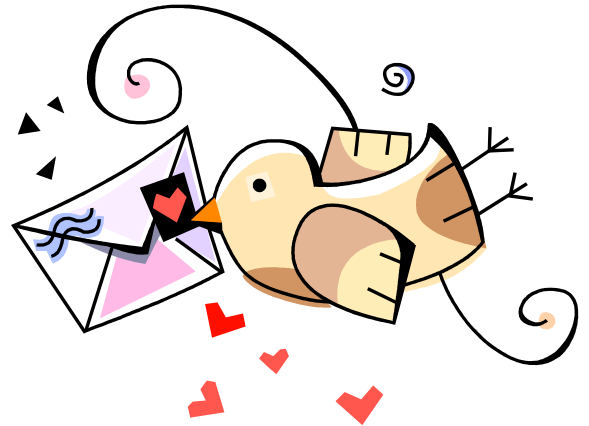

Parent Teacher Conferences

Parent-Teacher Conferences for the district are scheduled on February 3 from 4:00 to 8:00 and on February 4 from 2:00 to 8:00. Parents can find all teachers of seventh and eighth grade students in the 7-8 Commons for conferences and all sixth grade teachers will be posted in the 5-6 Commons for conferences. Fifth grade teachers will be scheduled in advance and meet with parents in their child's classroom.

Parents of 5th grade students must schedule appointments for conferences with their child's teacher. A letter will be sent home to parents to schedule a conference time slot.



State Assessments

The fifth and sixth students will be given the state reading assessment on March 24, 25, and 26. The math assessments for fifth and sixth grades will be given on March 30, 31, and April 1. The seventh and eighth graders will take both reading and math assessments on April 5, 6, and 7. The school is required to test all students. To help us accomplish this we ask that scheduled absences for doctor's appointments or other reasons not be made on those days. If appointments are unavoidable on those days please attempt to schedule them at or after 1:00 p.m.
